

Directions to Tuxford & Tebbutt, Melton Mowbray

From the South:

Exit the M1 at junction 21A, then keep right to join the A46 (signposted A46 Leics, Newark).

After several miles you will approach a roundabout. Take the inside lane and continue on the A46.

After half a mile take the slip road onto the A607 (signposted Melton Mowbray).

At the next 3 roundabouts take the 2nd exit onto the A607 (signposted Melton Mowbray).

Stay on the A607 until you enter Melton Mowbray.

You will pass a BP petrol station on your right. Go through the next traffic lights and take the right hand lane.

At the next set of traffic lights turn right onto Norman Way – A607 (signposted Grantham).

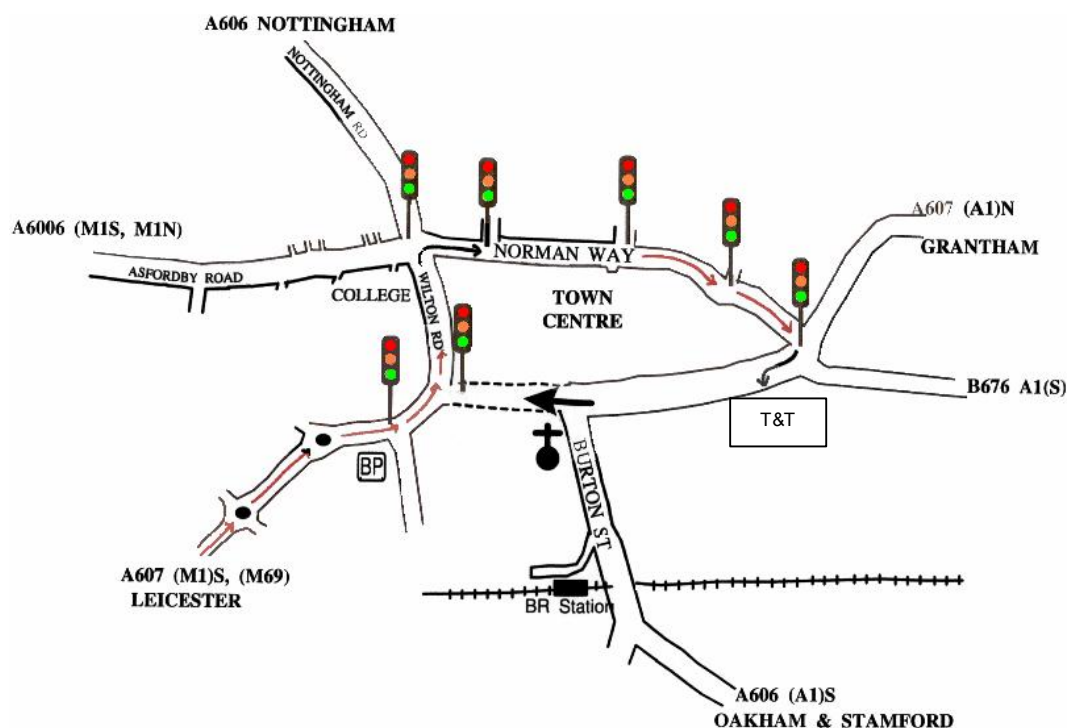
After 3 sets of traffic signals turn acutely right onto Thorpe End – A606 (signposted Oakham, Market Harborough, Leicester).

Tuxford & Tebbutt is immediately on your left hand side.

Parking

Turn into the Site. At the very front of the building there are 2 bays marked for Visitors. If these are occupied, continue past the reception building and you will see several more spaces on the left.

If these are full, there is a public car park to the left of the Site (to the right when leaving) which is a 'Pay & Display' car park.

From the North:

Depart the M1; exit 24 and take A6 south towards Kegworth.

Continue straight on through Kegworth to Hathern (still on A6).

Turn left onto the A6006 (Zouch Road) for 15.3 miles, passing through Rempstone and Wymeswold

At each roundabout continue on the A6006 until you get to Melton Mowbray. This will bring you straight onto the ring road called Norman Way.

Continue on Norman Way through several sets of traffic lights. Look out for a right turn signed for Oakham.

Get into the right hand lane and turn towards Oakham / Market Harborough / Leicester (direction of A606).

Tuxford & Tebbutt is immediately on your left hand side.

Parking

Turn into the Site. At the very front of the building there are 2 bays marked for Visitors. If these are occupied, continue past the reception building and you will see several more spaces on the left.

If these are full, there is a public car park to the left of the Site (to the right when leaving) which is a 'Pay & Display' car park.
